In three boxes there are additions. In one box it is subtraction.

2.

In one box there are both hundreds and tens. In three boxes there are only units.

3.

In three boxes, the sum or difference is 8. In one box, the sum is 12.

4.

In one box the terms are the same. In three boxes, the terms are different.

5.

In one box the terms are odd. In three boxes the terms are even.

6.

In three boxes, the sum or difference is an even number. In one box, the sum or difference is an odd number.

7.

In one box, the first term is twice as much as the second term. That is not the case in three of the boxes.

8.

In three boxes there are only units. In one box there are both units and tens.
